## Biography

**Krzysztof Szczypiorski** (born 1973 in Warsaw, Poland), received M.Sc. in telecommunications (with honours) at Faculty of Electronics and Information Technology (FEIT), Warsaw University of Technology (WUT) in 1997. In 2007 he received Ph.D. degree in telecommunications (with honours) also at FEIT, WUT. Since 1998 he has been working at Institute of Telecommunications, FEIT, WUT and since 2007 he has been an assistant professor. Dr. Krzysztof Szczypiorski has been teaching courses on local area networks, information security and electronic commerce. His research interests include three main areas: network security and steganography, wireless networks, and privacy in virtual society.

Since 1993 Dr. Krzysztof Szczypiorski has been working as a telecommunications specialist and since 1996 as an independent consultant in network security and telecommunications for many companies (including: Agora S.A., CitiBank, CC Open Systems, ClearWire Poland, EMAX S.A., Foundation "Fund of Cooperation" – PHARE, Hewlett-Packard Poland, National Institute of Telecommunications, JDS Consulting, Parliament of Republic of Poland, Lidl Poland, Ministry of Finance, Scientific and Academy Computer Network – Naukowo-Akademska Sieć Komputerowa NASK, Optimus S.A., Polkomtel S.A., PriceWaterhouseCoopers Poland, Rodan Systems S.A., Safe Computing, Średniawa Consulting, Telefonika Lokalna S.A., Telekomunikacja Polska S.A. (Polish Telecom), Exatel S.A. – formerly Tel-Energo S.A., Office of the Committee for European Integration, UOP/ABW – Internal Security Agency).

He is a founder and a head of International Telecommunication Union Internet Training Centre (ITU-ITC) established in 2003. At ITU-ITC he is a head of Cisco Regional Academy at WUT. He is a co-organizer of Security Research Group and a leader of Network Security Group.

Dr. Krzysztof Szczypiorski is an author or a co-author of over 60 papers, 2 patents, and over 30 invited talks on information security, telecommunications and electronic commerce. He participated in many R&D projects at Warsaw University of Technology (in seven of them also as a principal investigator). In 2007 he was a principle investigator in a R&D project on advanced network security systems sponsored by US Army and US Air Force. Since 2008 he has been participating in three projects funded by EU (Efipsans, ProSense, and Euro-NF) and another one funded by Polish Government on wireless sensor network. In ProSense project he is a principle investigator at WUT.

He is an author of several tens courses (for many companies, including: Siemens Poland, Postgraduate Studies in Telecommunications, Computer Science and Management – CITCOM PW, ITU Internet Training Centre). In 2003 he had graduated from Budapest Polytechnic (Hungary) and became a Cisco Certified Academy Instructor (CCAI) in CCNA, Network Security, Wireless LANs.

Frequently Dr. Krzysztof Szczypiorski attends international and domestic conferences on network security (over 50). He is also a supervisor of BSc and MSc theses (over 40 including 10 ongoing) in field of telecommunications and network security at FEIT, WUT.
